Observations after 8 years in Singapore Web Tech

The average developer

- Swaps job every ~2 years
- Is a career developer
- Rarely contributes to or creates open-source
- Has ~3 years experience
- Is not very familiar with engineering fundamentals or how they are relevant
- Is up-skilling by switching jobs or self-learning

The average employer

- Has a handful of engineers. The largest employers of software engineers are GovTech, a*star approaching 500...
- Is a ~4 year old tech startup

The JSConf Ingredients

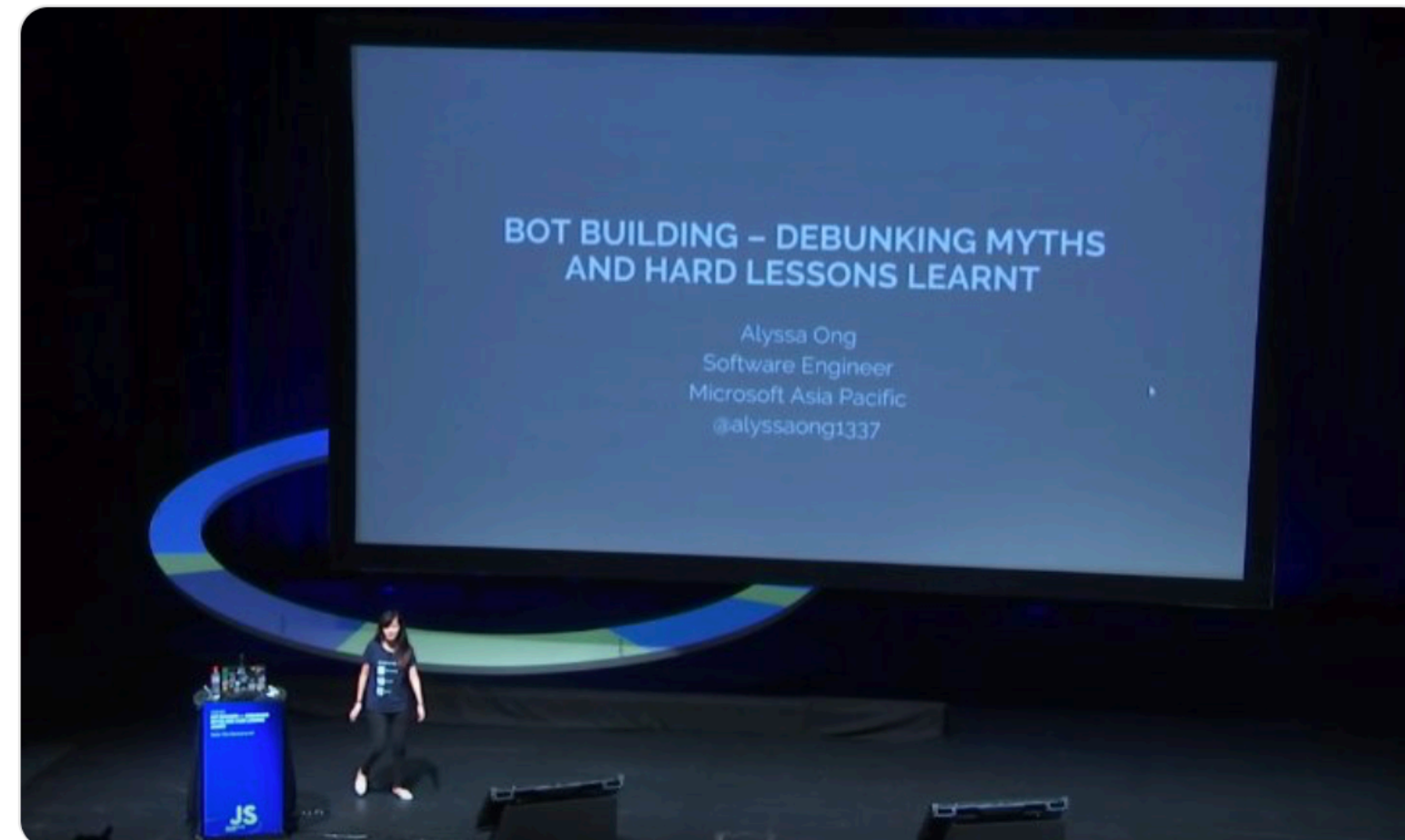
- Strong curation

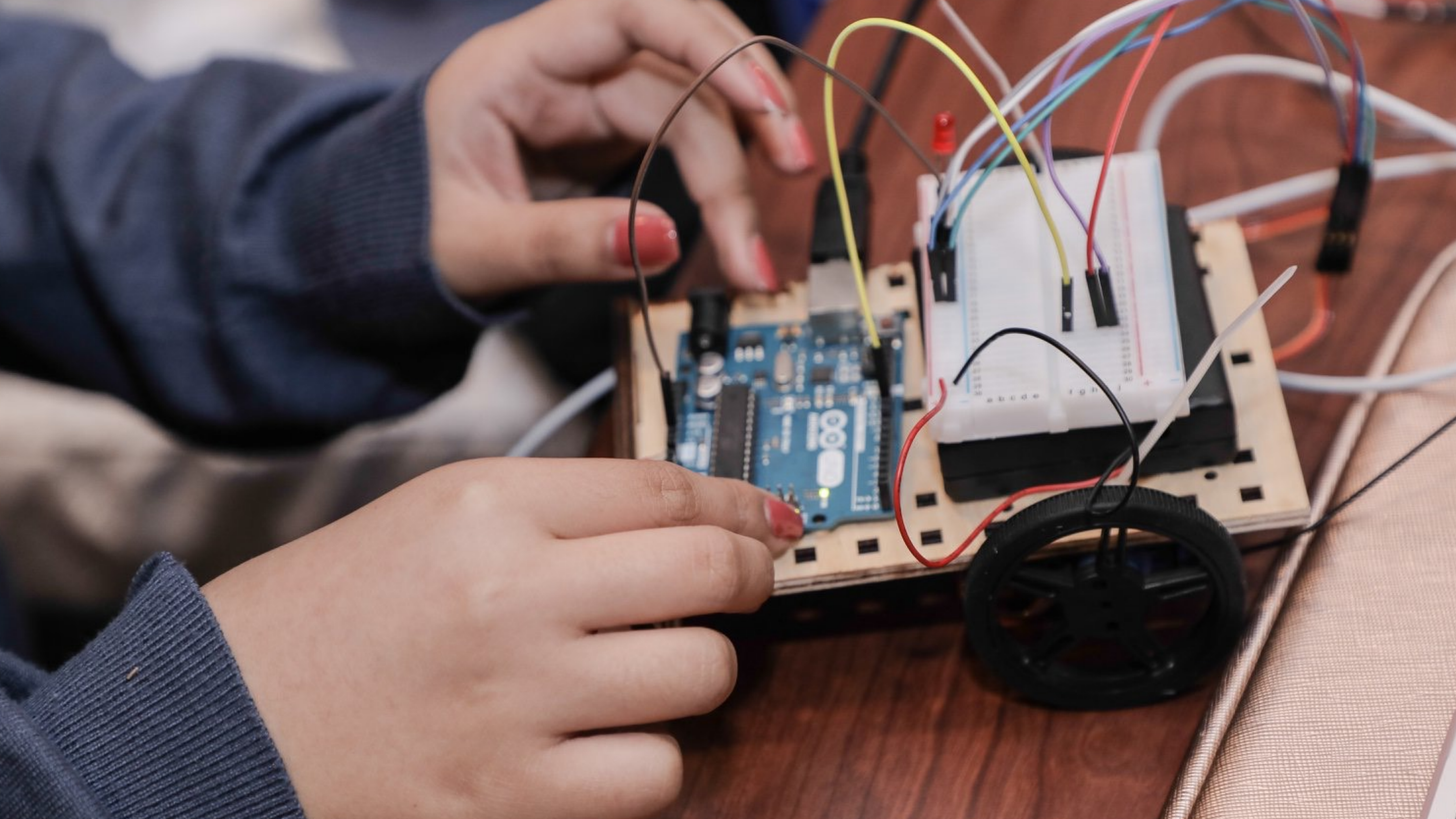
